



# SEABURY SCHOOL

## 2010-2011 Tuition Information

During the 2010-2011 school year, Seabury will serve students in PreKindergarten through Grade 8.

### APPLICATION FEE

**\$100.00** Non-refundable. This fee must accompany each application, information sheet and survey.

### 2010-2011 TUITION

- \$6,600.00** **PreKindergarten half-day program:** Upon written acceptance into the program, a \$660.00 non-refundable deposit must accompany the returned enrollment contract. This amount is deducted from the total tuition charge. Families may elect to pay the remaining contracted amount in one payment or in ten equal installments.
- \$10,290.00** **PreKindergarten full-day program:** Upon written acceptance into the program, a \$1029.00 non-refundable deposit must accompany the returned enrollment contract. This amount is deducted from the total tuition charge. Families may elect to pay the remaining contracted amount in one payment or in ten equal installments.
- \$13,630.00** **Elementary program:** Upon written acceptance into the program, a \$1,363.00 non-refundable deposit must accompany the returned enrollment contract. This amount is deducted from the total tuition charge. Families may elect to pay the remaining contracted amount in one payment or in ten equal installments.
- \$15,710.00** **Middle School program:** Upon written acceptance into the program, a \$1,571.00 non-refundable deposit must accompany the returned enrollment contract. This amount is deducted from the total tuition charge. Families may elect to pay the remaining contracted amount in one payment or in ten equal installments.

### CLASSROOM

Classroom fees cover the cost of supplies provided by the school and field trips.

<b>ELC</b>	\$200 (includes all field trips)
<b>Elementary</b>	\$375 (includes all field trips, except OPI)
<b>Middle School (5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>)</b>	\$250 (field studies are included in tuition fees)

### DEVELOPMENT PARTICIPATION
